What are we doing this week?

Reception Topic - Halloween / Bonfire Night Book of the week- Room on the Broom and other rhyming stories

Personal and Social Development- Confident to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions. Children will talk about how they would like to create their own monsters and fireworks.

Communication and Language - Uses talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events. Children will talk about events such as Halloween and Bonfire Night and discuss what happened and how it made them feel.

Physical Development - Handles tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control. Children to work on scissor control in activities such as making fireworks and monsters.

Literacy - Continues a rhyming string.: Links sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet. Children will find rhyming pairs left by the witch to put on her broom. Children will write Halloween and Bonfire Night cards.

Mathematics- Selects the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects. Children will make magic potions by placing the correct number of objects in the cauldron following a recipe card.

Understanding the World - Children talk about past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members. Children will talk about how they celebrate Halloween and Bonfire Night and how families celebrate differently.

Expressive Arts and Design - Manipulates materials to achieve a planned effect. Children will create firework dancing sticks and clay mud monsters.

Class 1: English- Our core book for this half term is 'Traction Man'. This week we will make our predictions about what we think the story is about and talk about some of our special toys. We will focus on the voiceover in the text and we will have a go at creating some of our own.

Maths- Addition and subtraction: Year 1 will be adding two single digit numbers by counting on. Year 2 will be adding a 2 digit number and 1 digit number crossing 10 and begin to subtract a 1 digit number from a 2 digit number.

Art/ D&T-We are going to find out about levers and moving mechanism and make our own moving mechanism. History- We will begin our History topic on Toys from the past by thinking about our favourite toys and describing them to our friends. We will think about if these toys have always been around or whether they are old or new.

R.E- We will think about the many reasons why people give gifts. We will talk about how it feels to both give and receive gifts.

P.E- Ball skills and games with Mr Ellison.

How to help at home- continue to read 3 times a week. Learn spellings and complete Maths homework which is on Class Dojo.

Class 2 :English - This week we begin our new book 'Ug: The Boy Genius', we will begin by thinking about how life would have been different for these early humans, before discussing when writing began, and what communication there would have been in the Stone Age.

Maths - We are doing a recap on addition this week and will then begin our work on subtraction. Class 2 were brilliant at their column addition before half term.

Science - Our science topic for this half term is electricity, we will begin by learning about different types of electricity and how they can be generated.

Topic - Our topic for this half term is the Stone Age, fitting in with our English book. We will begin by learning what prehistoric means and some of the different times in the Earth's history. We will then learn about how hunter-gatherers survived and what life was like.

Art - Our focus in art this half term is on autumn. We will begin by drawing leaves.

It is Parliament Week this week so Class 2 will be spending time learning about parliament and thinking about what matters to them. We will be working on campaign videos and using the work that we did on persuasive writing last half term to help us.

Help at Home - The spelling rule for this week is the suffix -ly, the spellings are on the Class Dojo page so practice at home on them would be brilliant. We are trying to improve our recall time with our 3, 4 and 5 times tables so please spend some time practising these.
