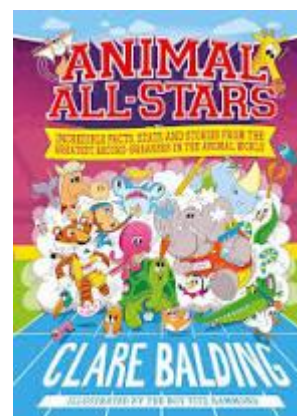
I am pleased to inform you that after school clubs will commence next week. Thank you for your understanding over the limited number of places. This is purely due to Health and Safety reasons.
