
Mathematics

Can you create a shape picture of a castle and name and count all the shapes you have used?



- Using Duplo, Lego or cubes can you create a tower? How many pieces of Lego, Duplo or cubes tall is your tower? Can you create different size towers and put the towers in order of tallest to shortest?
- On one of the towers stick the numbers 1-10. Can you put the tower together with the numbers in the correct order? You could even try 1-20.
- What do you think a day would be like in dragon school? Can you draw some pictures of your daily routine and put them in order. Think about the days of the week. Do you know what the first day of the week is? What days are the weekend? Can you put the days of the week in order?
- Create your own dragon school. Can you create your own clock and make up your own times for the dragons day.

What time do you think dragon school would start? What time might they eat their lunch? What time might they go to bed? Practice moving the hands on your clock to make the time to each hour.



- Can you design your own castle and then make it out of junk modelling materials?
- Can you make your own knight shield and sword using cardboard?
- Look at the different dragons in the illustrations. Can you draw / paint some more.
