#### Mathematics

**Our focus the week is counting in multiples.**

- We will be continuing to follow our school Maths scheme 'White Rose Maths'. You can find daily videos and activities for to do here: White Rose home learning Year 1 Summer Week 7

Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

- Can you count how many pairs of shoes you have in your house? Can you can how many pairs of socks you have? Remember to count in multiples of 2.
- Play 'multiples ball'. You need a ball and to stand in a circle of with your family. (You could even use your teddies) You pass the ball around the circle counting in tens, if you say 100 you are out. The winner is the person left standing. You can do this by counting in 5's (50)
- Watch this spy video all about multiples: <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/maths-ks1--ks2-multiples-of-two-five-and-ten/z769wty> Go outside and look for objects that appear in twos, fives or tens, or gather things to create groups of twos, fives and tens (leaves, sticks, pebbles)
- You could identify the multiples of two, five or ten on a number line, in a hundred square or on a multiplication grid. You could you 100 splat square online: <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/paint-the-squares>

- Make your own castle using cardboard boxes and other recycled materials. What 3D shapes did you use to make your castle?
- Map making - Create a bird's eye view map of a castle. What features lay within the castle walls?
- Local castles - Locate castles near to you and mark them on a UK map. Can you name the castles in Northumberland?
- Learn about the features of a castle. Label a castle picture correctly using the appropriate vocabulary.
- Design and make a knight shield.
