What's happening in my classroom?

Reception:

Books of the week- Zog by Julia Donaldson and lots of 'World Book Day' books.

Communication and Language- We will listen to a range of stoires throughout the week. We will read Zog and follow instructions on our activity trail. During 'World Book Day' we listen to a range of stories and share some of our favourite stories as we practice re-telling them using the same story language.

Personal and Social Development- We will talk about the characters in the stories we are reading throughout the week and discuss different characteristics e.g kindness and courage etc. Physical Development - In PE, we will go swimming and we will also continue our dance topic with Mr Ellison. We will continue to develop our fine motor skills as we complete our morning activities. Literacy- We will continue to follow our Read, Write Inc phonics programme and practice our single letter sounds and special friends sh, ch, th, ng, nk and ay. We find and write the rhyming words in the story.

Mathematics. We will practice combing groups of objects at our Zog Maths school. Understanding the World -. We will talk about where Kielder is compared to Bellingham. We will explore the Kielder activity trail.

Expressive Arts and Design -. We will continue with our music session with Mr Tait. We will complete a range of art and crafts activities linked to world book day and the story Zog.

Year 1:

Maths- This week we will be looking at Place Value up to 50. We will be looking at multiples of 10 as well as working out how many objects are in a group by making tens. English- This week, we are looking at the book 'Zog' and will be creating character descriptions and creating shape poems. We will also be writing a recount of our trip to Kielder.

Science- This week, we will be starting our topic looking at humans and naming different parts of the body.

History- This half term, our topic is Nurturing Nurses. This week we will be looking at significant individuals from the past and present.

R.E- We will be introducing our topic of Judaism and thinking about anything we know already.

D.T- This week, we will begin our topic looking at puppets and discussing different parts that are needed to make a puppet.

P.S.H.E- This week in P.S.H.E we will be using Jigsaw Jack to help us look at being healthy and what we can do to be healthy.

P.E- We will continue our weekly lessons with Mr Ellison as well as continuing our swimming lessons on a Thursday afternoon.

How to help at home-Please try and read at least 3 times at home.

We are offering parent/teacher discussions next Monday & Tuesday. This will be an opportunity for you to discuss your child's progress and next steps. In the absence of their class teacher, Mrs Goddard will be available to speak with Year 3 -4 parents.

Year 2:

We are having a take one book week based on 'Zog by Julia Donaldson. Year 2 will be doing these activities based on the story Zog:

Going on a trip on the Zog trial at Kielder forest.

We will be writing our own character descriptions based on Zog using expanded noun phrases.

We will be writing recounts about our trip on the Zog trial at Kielder forest using time connectives.

Designing and creating our own dragon by exploring the features that dragons have. Drawing a map for Zog's route to get to school.

Write a set of instructions to teach a young dragon how to fly like Zog.

Creating and designing dragon eyes using clay modelling.

Writing a similar story showing what different creatures might learn at their own schools (e.g. a unicorn, a mermaid, a superhero) based on the story of Zog.

World book day activities.

Years 3 &4

Take One Book ... Julia Donaldson

We will focus on stories by one of our favourite authors and explore the skills required to write a good story.

We have a visit to Kielder Forest planned to explore our locality and re-create characters/scenes from the story Zog and The Gruffalo. We will follow some of the story trails and develop some of our own.

On Thursday we'll be sharing some of our favourite stories, reading for pleasure and enjoying our reading areas in school. We can read aloud to our friends.

Spellings and handwriting will be our focus in our written work – creating our own stories.

Music – singing with Mr Tait.

Helping at home - Can you read at least three times with your child at home this week? Can you practice times tables at home?


In the absence of Miss Moore, we have been fortunate to secure Mrs English to work with Years 3 & 4 for the next few weeks.
