We will have special procedures in place to support the track & trace process during the Christmas holidays. School staff are asked to be available up to and including Christmas Eve to provide information to Track & Trace and Public Health England.

Should your child develop symptoms within 48 hours of being in school (19th- 20th December) you must follow these procedures:

- Arrange for your child to be tested.
- Contact our school admin email address on firstadmin@bellinghampartnership.uk before 11am with the results of the test so school can notify possible contacts. This notification will be via Class Dojo to the 'bubble' it concerns.
- You and your family must self-isolate if you receive a positive result.

If your child develops symptoms on or after Sunday 20th December you are responsible for contacting 'Track & Trace' and do not need to let school know.

Should this result in you or your child having to isolate please let us know when we return to school on Tuesday 5th January.
