Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

- This story focuses on Anna Hibiscuses family. Can you draw a picture of your family and write a description of each person? You could play a guess 'who this is in our family game?' Make sure you use lots of great adjectives to describe them.
- The story is set in Africa. Can you research Africa? What is life there like? Do they have the same climate as us? You could do a poster all about Africa or an information booklet.
- Write a poem about where Anna Hibiscus lives. You could start by writing words or phrases on a pieces of paper and then put them together to make a poem. This is an example:

Busy
Cool, forgotten places
Cousins playing and shouting
Exciting place to hide

- Imagine Anna was coming to see you.
 What questions would you like to ask her?
 Write them down and remember to use a
 question mark at the end. You could even
 pretend to be Anna or get someone in
 your family to be Anna and ask them
 questions.
- You could use colours, patterns and motifs
 of traditional fabrics from Nigeria, and
 other African countries, to design and
 print your own fabric in readiness for
 Aunty Comfort's visit and the ensuing
 family feast.

Our focus the week is adding and subtracting



- Play addition and subtraction games online. Here

 Can you beat your top score?
- You could put numbers (2 digit numbers) in a paddling pool. Children fish out two numbers.
 Can they write an addition and a subtraction number sentence using the numbers?
- Play number bond to 100 snap (you will need number cards
 (0,10,20,30,40,50,50,60,70,80,90,100)
 Place numbers face down and turn 2 over at a time. If they make 100 then you can keep them. If you are really good you could make it harder by using numbers such as 93/7 52/48 ect
- Challenge: If I add an even number to an even number it will equal an equal number. Is this correct? How could you work this out? Try this one:

An odd number add an odd equals an odd number. Is this correct? How would you work it out?

- Can you create your own part whole model using these numbers:
 - **4** 46, 22, 24
 - Write the addition and subtraction
 number sentences to go with these part
 whole models.

 - ❖ Words ending in 'ly' badly slowly lovely sweetly quietly shyly brightly
- ✓ Please continue to read every day.
- ✓ Practise your cursive handwriting using the support sheet.
 Learn how to read and spell year 2 common exception words
 - Can you use Scratch Jr app to create your own seaside moving video? Try and remember how we made these at school. You could have people or sea creatures moving and add voices.
 - Locate different seaside places from around the UK using a map. How many can you locate? Here are some to find: Newquay, Whitby, Whitley Bay, Scarbourgh, Great Yarmouth.
 - Can you create your own seaside picture? You could use paint, collage materials, outdoor materials such as sand.
 - Can you remember going to the beach? Where was the beach? What kind of things did you do? You could ask your parents, grandparents about what they did when they went to the beach. Was it the same as you?
 - A popular seaside activity was a Punch and Judy puppet show. You can watch lots of these videos on you tube. Can you create your own Punch and Judy show?
