

 Can you imagine what the characters in the story would be saying? Write in the speech bubbles below what they would be saying. Remember you


Mathematics

Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

 Can you make arrays using objects from around your house? You could use toy cars, teddies, cereal. You could say show me '3 lots of 4' or show me '3x4'.



- Play double snake and ladders game. Can you answer the double calculations to move up the board?

- Super Daisy wants you to solve these sharing problems:
- > 10 sweets shared into 5 groups
- > 6 teddies shared into 3 equal groups
- > 12 biscuits shared into 4 equal groups

You could try writing your own sharing problems

 Can you collect 10 items from around your house? How many equal groups can you put them into? (2, 5, 10)

- Can you collect 12 items from around your house? How many equal groups can you put them into? (2,3,4,6,12)

- Can you create your own superhero identity? What would your super power be? You could create your own super hero costume.



- Who is your superhero? This could be your Mum, NHS workers. Who do you look up to? You could write them a letter to tell them that they are your superhero.
- Over time lots of people have been seen as real life superheroes such as Florence Nightingale. Can
 you find out facts about Florence Nightingale? You can watch a video all about

- Can you do these superhero crafts that I have uploaded? You could even design and make your own.
- Do superhero Science experiments such as supersize marshmallows, flying superheroes. You could write about your findings. I will upload these experiments.
