Virtual Author Visit – Classes 1 & 2. Tuesday 9th November.

We will be taking part in an on-line author event with some of our other nearby primary schools to 'meet' Ross Collins.

We have some copies of his books in school to share before the event and have forwarded some questions ready to ask him.

We've read some of Ross Collins' stories in class and enjoyed them!



We will be doing additional active Maths activities every day this week. On Friday 12^{th} November children can come to school dressed as a rockstar (to promote Timetables Rockstars) or in a number/ shape costume to celebrate our love of Maths.



We have Remembrance Day items available in school this week - all donations accepted.

What are we doing in our classrooms this week...?

Reception Topic - Snap, Crackle, Pop Theme of the week-Night time and festivals.

Communication and Language- We will talk about Bonfire Night and describe our experiences in as much detail as we can.

Personal and Social Development- During Maths Day we will focus on working as a team to complete a range of Maths challenges inside and outside the classroom.

Physical Development - In PE, we will continue to take part in a range of games with Mr Ellison. We will continue to develop our fine motor skills by writing our letter sounds and names in glitter using a paintbrush. Literacy- This week we will be learning the letter sounds u, b and f. We will practise our blending by reading words around the classroom as we go on a bonfire night hunt. We will build up our own words on rockets and begin to write CVC words.

Mathematics- In Maths we will consolidate our understanding of numbers 1-5 focusing on number bonds to 5. We will begin to use a tens frame and play games to support this. We will begin to look at shapes and discuss the key feautres of simple 2D shapes. On Friday we have our Maths day and we will engage in a variety of Maths challenges in the classroom and during Forest Schools.

Understanding the World - We will talk about our bonfire night experiences. We will learn about Diwali and look at the similiarities and differences to the events we celebrate. We will also talk abou t Remembrance Day.

Expressive Arts and Design - We will create our own firework and Remembrance Day pictures. In Forest Schools we will create fireworks using outside materials and draw rangloi patterns using chalks.

Class 1:

English- Our core book this half term is 'The Bluebird and the Robot". This week we will be learning about conjunctions (and, but, so, or). We will be creating speech and thought bubbles for the robots. We will also be doing activities based on Ross Collins following on from the author visit. Maths- Year 1 will be learning to subtract a 1 digit number to a 2 digit number. Year 2 will be learning how to use lots of different methods to solve addition sentences such as column addition, using a number line.

Science- This week we will be identifying materials from around the classroom and learning about how the materials feel.

History- This week we will be learning about what life was like in London at the time of 'The Great Fire of London'.

Design & Technology- This week we will be labelling a fire engine and learning about the different parts of the appliance.

P.E- Mr Ellison will be doing games this half term with a focus on multi skills and games.

R.E- This half term we will be learning about how Christians celebrate Christmas. This week we will be discussing what festivals we celebrate.

Computing- This half term we will be learning about coding. We will be using the app scratch jr and exploring it this week.

P.S.H.E- This week we will be learning about how to have a growth mindset and how we can have a growth mindset in class.

How to help at home- Can you retell the story that you are reading?

Class 2:

English - We will begin the week with story writing based on a picture. This week we are working on our descriptive writing as we write about a new act in the show in 'Leon and the place between'. We have been practising performing our poems and reading out our work recently, this week we will practise performing a section from the story as a group. Year 3 are going to be learning about vowels and consonants, whilst Year 4 practise writing in paragraphs. Year 5 will be recapping using paragraphs whilst also continuing our work on relative clauses and pronouns from this week.

Maths - We are doing lots of work on our times tables this week, Year 3 will be learning their 3 and 4 times tables this week. Year 4 will be learning their 6 and 9 times tables as well as multiplying and dividing by 0, 1, 10, 100 and 1000. Year 5 will be working on finding factors of numbers then using this new knowledge to find common factors between different numbers, before learning about prime and square numbers towards the end of the week.

Science - We are going to be investigating reflective surfaces this week, we will be checking if various materials are reflective. Year 5 will also be making a periscope and learning how light is reflected.

Topic - We begin our Vikings topic this week by ordering timelines of key events during the Vikings period. We will then be creating posters of information based on what we have learned about the Vikings.

RE - We will be creating our own word art based on Christmas and Nativity words.

D&T - We will be using our designs from last week to make our own Viking shields from cardboard - if you have any spare cardboard boxes at home, we would be very appreciative if we could use them on Friday! French - We will be finding out how to say who is in our family.

PE - Swimming with Mr Ellison and swimming on Thursday.

We have our virtual author event with Ross Collins on Tuesday.
