## What are we doing in our classrooms this week...?

Reception Topic - Snap, Crackle, Pop Theme of the week- A range of Christmas stories.

Communication and Language- We will learn the lyrics to the songs in the Christmas play.

**Personal and Social Development-** We will introduce the story 'The snowman and the snowdog' and we will complete a range of 'acts of kindness' activities.

**Physical Development** - We will practice our scissor control as we cut out Santa's beard and cut out baubles to go on the tree.

Literacy- We will continue our RWI programme and we will introduce the tricky words 'I' and 'the'. We will have lots of writing opportunities such as writing Christmas cards, lists and labels. We will write our own Christmas Cards

Maths- In Maths, we begin to focus on one more and one less using lots of physical objects and songs. We then begin some addition using our Christmas workshop to add different amounts of presents together.

**Understanding the World** - We will talk about how we each celebrate Christmas and how different families have different traditions.

Expressive Arts and Design - We will continue to learn our songs for the Christmas play and continue our music lessons with Mr Burns. We will create our own role play stories in Santa's workshop.

Class 1: English- Our focus this week will be Christmas. We will be writing letters to Santa Claus and to our class elf Snozzle Trump. We will be ordering and sequencing the Christmas story and writing our own Christmas story.

Maths: We will be doing lots of fun Christmas Maths challenges to help us consolidate our knowledge of place value, addition and subtraction. We will also be using our 2D shape knowledge to create Christmas pictures.

Science- Our topic this half term is materials. This week we will be designing a toy for Santa's workshop and saying what materials we would use and why.

History- Our topic this half term is 'The Great Fire of London'. This week we will be learning about how the fire was stopped and comparing it to how we would stop a fire now.

Design & Technology- Our topic this half term is designing and making a fire engine. This week we will be finished off our fire engines and adding the wheels and axles to them.

Art- We will be designing and making our Christmas cards and calendars.

P.E- Mr Ellison will be doing Christmas themed games this week with a focus on multi skills.

R.E- This week we will be learning about the Christmas story and why Christians celebrate Christmas.

P.S.H.E- This week we will be learning about how different people celebrate Christmas. Music- Mr Burns will be teaching us some Christmas songs.

How to help at home- When you are reading a bedtime story can you ask your child to tell you what is happening in the story?

## Class 2:

English - This week we will be writing our stories that we planned last week, we will be creating front covers and writing a blurb also.

Maths - We will be continuing our work on lengths and area. Year 3 will be adding lengths, Year 4 will be making shapes of a given area and Year 5 will be working on calculating the area of compound shapes. We will also be doing some Christmas codebreaking.

Science - We will be learning about transparent, translucent and opaque materials. Year 5 will be learning about how the eye works.

Topic - We will find out about rationing during World War Two this week.

DT - We will be making our Viking longships this week.

PE - Multi skills with Mr Ellison and swimming on Thursday.
