#### **English**

Our story this week is: How to Find Gold by Viviane Schwarz. We will be continuing to follow our school English scheme 'Power of Reading'. I will upload the planning to our class page. Upload your completed activities to our class dojo page.

Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

- Can you design and make a treasure box as special as that sought by Anna and Crocodile? You could label your treasure box using adjectives or write a set of instructions on how to make your treasure box.
- Create a story map to help you to retell the story. You could draw key points of the story and write down key phrases. Retell the story to a member of your family or you could record your retelling of the story and send it to a family member. Here is an example of a story map:



- Can you create your own adventure for Anna and Crocodile? You could create your own story book. Where do you think they would go next? Make sure your story has lots of problems for them to overcome together.

#### **Mathematics**

# Our focus the week is length, height and weight.

Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

- Go on a walk and collect lots of different objects such as sticks, leaves ect. Can you order the objects that you collected from shortest to longest?
- Create a car ramp like this: Can you measure how far the cars have travelled?





- Go around your house and find objects that are bigger and smaller than you. Can you find any objects that are the same size as you? Can you measure objects using your hands or cubes? How long are they? Can you use a ruler to measure objects? Remember to use cm.
- Make a scale by using a coat hanger. Can you compare how much objects weigh using <>=?
   Which object is heavier/lighter?



Create a large piece of artwork that captures the energy, mood and atmosphere of the underwater world that Anna and Crocodile experience. You could write a description of the underwater world.

- Bake a cake or fairy cakes. Follow the recipe and weigh out the ingredients carefully. What did you use to measure out the ingredients? What units did you use?
- A bag of sugar weighs 1kg. Can you go around your house and find objects that weigh 1kg?




- ✓ Can you practise your RWI sounds? You can watch daily RWI lessons at:

  These would be the same daily phonics lessons that children would take part in at school.
- ✓ Please continue to read every day.
- Practise your cursive handwriting using the support sheet.
   Learn how to spell and read Year 1 common exception words.
  - Can you find out all about what holidays were like from the past? Try to look for information on what they were like from Victorian times. Talk about how they were different to our seaside trips. Here is a video to help: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zWqnpY4L9so
  - What objects float and sink? Find a range of objects to test. Use the bath or a washing up bowl to see if these objects float or sink. Make predictions before you start about whether you think the objects will float or sink. You could record this in a table.
  - What animals live in the sea? Research sea creatures and find out lots of different fact about animals that live in the sea. Can you make a sea creature out of junk modelling or using different materials?
