Year 2-98%

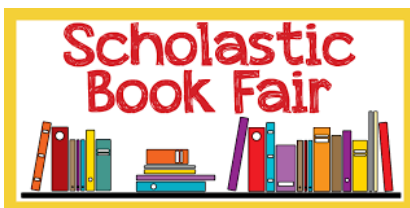
